Independent District Engineering Services, LLC (Engineer) was hired by the Jefferson Center Metropolitan District No. 1 (District) to provide verification of expenditures of the District related to District contracts associated with improvements and services (District Expenditures) for the Candelas Development located in the City of Arvada, Colorado (Project). Some of the District contracts have expenditures for both Districteligible and non-eligible improvements and services. This document summarizes the engineer's approach and findings for such expenditures.

ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED

To provide verification of District Expenditures, a review of the relevant District contracts, invoices and pay applications submitted to the District was performed. These were invoices and pay applications submitted to the District and run through the District invoice process. Invoices which are paid through General or Debt Fund categories were not reviewed but are shown as Operating and Maintenance Expenditures to reflect the grand total of District expenditures for the month. A Contract Summary is also provided, detailing contract amounts and balances through this period. Additionally, any invoices withheld from payment are also summarized.

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION

After completing the activities identified, in our professional opinion, we have concluded the following:

- 1. At this time and based upon the information provided, we find \$514,451.92 of the District Expenditures were appropriately classified as District Eligible Expenses.
- 2. At this time and based upon the information provided, we find \$3,131.87 of the District Expenditures were appropriately classified as Non-Eligible Expenses.
