A Contract Summary is also provided, detailing contract amounts and balances through this period. Additionally, any invoices withheld from payment are also summarized.

### SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION

After completing the activities identified, in our professional opinion, we have concluded the following:

- 1. At this time and based upon the information provided, we find **\$335,943.49** of the District Expenditures were appropriately classified as District Eligible Expenses.
- 2. At this time and based upon the information provided, we find **\$0.00** of the District Expenditures were appropriately classified as Non-Eligible Expenses.
